





### **STAGE 1 WOMEN**

- Start at Heavenly California Base
- Full clockwise 72-mile loop of Lake
   Tahoe
- The route will feature a climb at Emerald Bay on the West Shore before reaching North Lake Tahoe
- As the race traverses the East Shore, teams will begin working to set up contenders for the short but steep uphill finish on Ski Run Blvd. to Heavenly Mountain Resort

### **STAGE 5 MEN'S FINISH**

- From Lodi on a long gradual ascent to an uphill finish in South Lake Tahoe, reaching a peak elevation of 8,600 feet - the highest in race history!
- The ride, essentially a 130-mile climb that gains in elevation from 50 to 6,650' at the finish, will showcase California's diversity, from the rich soil of the Central Valley to the mighty peaks of the Sierra Nevada Mountains


